Couriers of God's Presence

“Courier”: One who bears messages or information; esp. for Diplomatic or military service; a messenger sent in “haste” with important letters or messages; a messenger who is entrusted to carry and care for that which he is to deliver – usually God's. II Chronicles 30:6 And the couriers went throughout all Israel and Judah with letters from the king and his leaders, and spoke according to the command of the king... Esther 8:14 The couriers who rode on royal horses went out, hastened and pressed on by the king's command.

The “couriers”, or messengers/runners, described in the above scriptures delivered messages from an earthly king—under penalty of death for failure to deliver their communications concerning important military or political information. They were willing to risk everything for this prestigious position—even their lives. They knew that in exchange for their high-profile job and the perks that came with it there was no margin for error—mistakes were not tolerated—in this job, one strike and you're dead. Revelations 12:10. And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.

Peter and John lived out the above scripture. They were fearless of harm, reproach, persecution, and even death. (Acts 4:13-21) You see, Peter and John were true couriers of God's presence. In Acts 3, a crippled man is healed. In verse 6, Peter said, “Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk.” In verses 11 & 12, Peter sees the amazement of the people who had seen the lame man healed, and seizes the moment to minister to them.

Even when faced with threats of imprisonment and beatings (Acts 4:17-21), the Apostles continued to preach fearlessly, filled with the Holy Spirit (Acts 4:8), and with signs and wonders and miracle healings. (Acts 5:12, 13 & 18) Thousands were saved—they turned that city “upside right”—everywhere they went, they “steamrolled” the devil—near riots turned into revival—the anointing was so powerful that Peter's shadow healed people walking down the street! The Apostles burned to deliver the message entrusted to them, (Jeremiah 20:9) and they asked the Lord to give them more boldness. (Acts 4:29)

If the couriers of old were willing to risk their very lives to deliver a message from an earthly king, how can we not be like the Apostles, and be couriers for the Lord? As Spirit Filled believers, we are vessels in the truest sense of the word. In essence, we are the Lord's postmen, delivering His presence to the uttermost parts of the world. 2 Corinthians 5:21 Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God.

Our citizenship is in the Heavens. We have a mandate from God to preach the Gospel throughout the world. We need to deny ourselves, pick up His cross, and be people of prayer who travail, just like David. In Psalm 119:136 he says, “Rivers of water run down from my eyes because men do not keep my law.” David is crying and interceding for the sins of mankind, and for the lost. God has called His people to be a people of prayer, a people of surrender, so that we can stand in the gap to reach a lost and dying world—to be Ambassadors for Christ—couriers of His presence. As Ambassadors for Christ, we are entrusted with a treasure—and that treasure is the anointing of the Spirit of God. We are the earthly vessels of this treasure—the temple of God in which His Spirit dwells. (2 Cor. 4:1-8)

The predictions of the end times are upon us, but remember, as Matthew 24:14 says, ...the gospel of the kingdom will be preached throughout the world as a witness to all the nations. Choose to be part of the endtime revival. If you have been A.W.O.L. from the Army of God because of unfulfilled dreams, disappointments or hurts, it's time for you to re-enlist! No person reading this has suffered the way the Apostles suffered, and consider Christ who endured three nails and a rugged cross. Crucified = Forgiven. Remember the day you were saved? That's the day you enlisted in the Army of God. In this army, you already have the weapons you need: your mouth is the barrel of the gun, and His words are the bullets—so take your hand off the safety, pull the trigger and speak them into the lives of those around you. Fulfill your destiny as a courier of His Presence!



It's been about 7 years since my last trip to Australia. I have Many fond memories of this beautiful country. In 1980, I competed In the Mr. Olympia contest at the Sydney Opera House in Sydney, Australia with none other than "The Terminator" himself, Arnold Schwarzenegger, as well as many other world champion bodybuilders. It was one of my first competitions as a Christian, and as it turned out, it was a very controversial event. They were also filming a movie about Arnold called, "The Comeback". This time, I was not only in competition; I was also able to share my faith—during interviews, personal appearances, and many other venues. Even though Arnold was declared the winner, in losing I had peace, and came back the following year to win the title of Mr. Universe.

As my wife, my son and I were leaving on a midnight flight from LAX to Sydney, we were filled with anticipation for this trip. We were picked up at the airport by evangelist and long-time friend Tom Bachtle, and even with extreme jet-lag after our 16 hour flight, we couldn't wait to get to our hotel, change and go to Hillsong Church, where I had the opportunity to meet with Pastor Brian Houston and worship leader Darlene Zschech. I had the privilege of praying with many athletes who saw my picture on the screen during Pastor Houston's meeting. Imagine my delight at knowing how many wanted to meet and pray with "The Sermonator"!

Our time in Sydney was a fantastic experience—meeting new people, sharing our faith, and having many divine assignments. From there we headed to Brisbane, on Australia's Gold Coast, holding eight consecutive meetings between Wednesday and Sunday night. People attended the Easter Leadership Conference at Reach Out for Christ from all around the world, and God moved! Wherever we went, we had divine opportunities to share our faith and to pray and prophesy over people. From the gym to the zoo, from the coffee shops to the football stadium, people were saved, re-dedicated their lives, and the Lord continuously poured out His anointing. Many people shared their testimonies with my son, D.J. and I. They told of meetings they had attended on my previous trips to Australia, and talked of saved marriages, prophecies fulfilled, healings and lives begun anew.

This trip was particularly special, because it showed my son the fruits of ministry—that it's truly all about touching people for Christ. He was amazed by the testimonies he heard, and at 17, he gained a new insight into what my life is about.

Aside from the rainy weather and my bag causing a bomb scare at the Sydney airport (that story's a newsletter in itself!), our trip down under was a tremendous blessing. Topping it all off, we stopped in New Zealand on the way home, and dropped in on some friends who were working on the film "The Last Samurai," starring Tom Cruise. We truly would have loved to stay longer, but all too soon it was time to return to LA.

I am so thankful that God has called me as a prophetic voice to the nations, and that the doors continue to open for my ministry.

And the Spirit of the Lord Would Say:

Australia may have been birthed as a penal colony, but I am moving in this land. It is a strategic place where I will raise up leaders, as it says in Ephesians 4:11. I desire the church in Australia to be like an aircraft carrier. It shall launch out my purified, trained-up servants to declare my gospel. My message shall be sent to Asia, New Zealand, the South Pacific, and throughout the world.

As the spirit of terrorism rises up, and innocent blood is shed, everywhere you look there seems to be an increase in war, devastation and a spirit of darkness over the land. Just recently, many Australians died in Bali. Because of this devastation, many of my people have drawn back, and even question and doubt that my divine protection and my agape love is being released today. But even as my Word has witnessed that these things would happen, know that my Word also says that: "As you draw nigh to me, I will draw nigh to you." This is a time to draw closer to me. This is a time for the deep to call unto the deep. I am raising up a mighty army that will be the Remnant of God. They will bring in the last end-time harvest. They will not give in to fear. They will not give in to threats of war, famine, SARS disease, recession or terrorism. As it says in Daniel 12:10: "Many shall purified, and be made white and refined..." That's the Bride — the Remnant of the Church of God! They shall shine with the Glory of God upon them. But the wicked shall grow even more wicked. And they shall not understand the ways of God or the ways of righteousness.

God is now making a distinction as he did in the time of Pharaoh—a time of a paradigm shift. His Army shall come forth. This is a time of new consecration and sanctification.

We shall arise, and his light shall shine upon us, in us and through us. This Remnant shall be a people as in Daniel 11:32: "Those who know their God shall be strong and carry out great exploits." By faith and by prayer and the words that they declare, the powers of darkness shall be bound and my spirit loosed, because they know that the gates of hell shall not prevail against the Church.

It is a place where there is healing, a place where there is revelation, a place where there is illumination, a place of consecration, a place of dedication, a place of restoration, and a place for saturation. So come on in; come on in. And I'll speak to you, and give you refreshing and joy, and the strategic plans to fulfill your destiny and purpose. And through your obedience, many will follow, and the end-time harvest will be complete. So choose to be a laborer in this end time harvest, for my Word says, "Those who turn people to the Lord shall shine like the stars forever." (Daniel 12:3)
